



State Project No. 76-205

Intersection Improvements Routes 6 & 44 and New State Road at Middle Turnpike West

In the Town of Manchester

The Project consisted of the reconstruction and realignment of two heavily traveled intersections with improved access to Cheney Tech and East Catholic High Schools. The first intersection reconstructed was at Middle Turnpike, Center Street and the entrance to Cheney Technical High School. The second intersection reconstructed was at Middle Turnpike, New State Road and the entrance to East Catholic High School. In addition to the roadway improvements new drainage systems were installed, accessible sidewalks with stamped concrete were added, traffic signals were installed with accessible pedestrian crosswalk controls and numerous plantings were installed throughout the project. With the project so close to the Hockanum River a large sediment pond with one of the State's largest level spreaders ever constructed was installed to pretreat storm water prior to getting to the river.

Project 76-205, was awarded to Spazzarini Construction Corp. on March 16, 2010, at a cost of \$5,278,865.33. The Contractor was ordered to start on April 1, 2010.

As this was a heavily traveled roadway with two high schools, commercial businesses, residential housing and a large amount of utility relocation work, there was lots of coordination and communication between the State's Contractor, State's Designers, the staffs at Cheney Tech and

East Catholic High along with the Town of Manchester to keep everyone happy. Making sure the students arrived at school on time and keeping the entrances to the school flowing during construction was a challenge. Everyone agrees that work done by this project is a great improvement compared to how it used to be. All parties involved should be very proud of this project and they all deserve our thanks for a job well done.
